Our aim is to support you as fully as we can in the current climate and also to set up arrangements that are not going to be disrupted whatever the events of the next few months. We have therefore set up our open sessions on the following basis:

- At the set time and date follow the link and you will be able to join the meeting.
- The meetings will follow the format of:
 - An introduction from the Headteacher, David Forrester
 - A pre-recorded tour of the school site
 - An open opportunity to talk and ask questions of some of our Y6 children
 - An open Q&A with the Headteacher to summarise

This structure is about as close as we can get to our normal sessions, which are very much about you as parents getting an insight into the everyday experience for children at Stoke Bishop C of E Primary School.
