<p>Wednesday 22nd May</p> <p>Group 1 (9.30 – 10.00am) Group 2 (10.30 –11.00am)</p>	<p><u>'Getting to know you' Session 1</u> Parents and children will be able to meet adults from the team, in small groups for story reading, games and songs/music. This will be outside if dry or in the hall/dining hall if wet. Our Family Link Worker will be available for questions and there will also be a member of the PTA available selling second hand uniform and providing tea and coffee. This will be outside if dry or in a space in school if wet. Parents will be able to go for coffee and tea with the PTA and our Family Link Worker will be available for questions. You will need to sign up to a home visit during this session if you haven't already done so.</p>

The kitchen will be serving sample school dinner tasters at 6.15pm.</p>	<p><u>Parents Information Session</u> This will be an adult only event where a brief presentation will take place centred around your child starting school and what a typical day in Reception might look like. You will have the opportunity to visit the classroom and explore some of the activities your child will be doing during their day at school. You will also find out which class your child will be in. The school kitchen will be open for you to sample our school dinner menu and the PTA will also be selling second hand uniform. Our Family Link Worker and Inclusion Lead will be available for questions and support.</p>
