

# Home Learning Year 3 and 4 Terms 3 and 4 : Anglo Saxons

We would like your child **to pick at least one activity from each of the categories below so they must complete a minimum of three pieces of work over the terms.** Or, why not surprise us with your own creative project related to our topic? We will celebrate the children's achievements in class throughout the term.



### **ESSENTIAL**

- Reading every day, including weekends for 10-15 minutes, preferably with an adult.
  - Spelling practice at least four times per week for 5-10 minutes.
  - Times table practise each week at home using Times Tables Rock Stars.
- **Please note**: Further English and Maths homework may be set, when additional support or consolidation is required.

This will not be a weekly expectation.

#### Choose one research activity

Write a fact file about Britain after the Romans. What facts interest you? What is the most interesting thing you found out?

**Create your own slide show about the Anglo Saxons-** Think about how you might organise each page (e.g. settlements, kingdoms, beliefs etc)

**Create your own Anglo Saxon god**- draw and explain your design. Which animal represents your god and what is their role? Choose one of these <u>creative</u> activities Make your own 5<sup>th</sup> Century feast!-

#### Choose one creative writing activity


Write a letter to King Vortigern – give him some advice on how to deal with the invading tribes (Scots and Saxons).









