What was life like for children during World War II (WW2) in Bristol?

This is the home learning sheet for Terms 5 and 6. We would like your child to complete *all of the essential activities* and complete *at least 4 tasks* from the topic-based list during the two terms, or surprise us with something else related to our topic and learning in class! We will celebrate the children's achievements and activities in class throughout the term.

Essential

- Reading every day, including weekends for 10-15 minutes, preferably with an adult. Please ensure the Reading Record is completed each week.
- Spelling practice at least four times per week for 5-10 minutes.
- Times tables practice at home using TT Rock Stars

Topic based

History

- Create a timeline of the key events during WW2 (1939-1945).
- Research what it was like for children in Bristol during WW2.
- Research an inspirational person from WW2.

Art

- Design your own poster (rationing, land army etc)

Geography

- Draw a map locating the major British cities targeted during The Blitz.
- Find out where in the UK children were evacuated to.

English

- Interview / carry out some research on the experiences of a family member or friend during WW2.
- Imagine you are an evacuee. Write a diary entry about some of your experiences.
- Write a story about the adventures of an evacuee.
- Read a book about WW2 or that is set during WW2.
