You will need to sign up to a home visit during this session if you haven't already done so.</p>

You will have the opportunity to visit the classroom and explore some of the activities your child will be doing during their day at school. You will also find out which class your child will be in. The school kitchen will be open for you to sample our school dinner menu and the PTA will also be selling second hand uniform. Our Family Link Worker and Inclusion Lead will be available for questions and support.</p>
