You could then complete some of the other suggested activities below or think of your own linked to our learning. We would love to see your learning on Tapestry.

SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES

- Draw and label a knight.
- Research a castle - you could look at books or search online.
- Go to the library and see if you can loan stories or non-fiction texts about castles.
- Write about a castle you have visited.
- Sketch a dragon.
- Make a stick puppet character/draw someone from medieval times.
- Research people who lived in a castle and write about their roles.
- Make a castle at home and take a photograph (from blankets/sheets; Lego; playdough; recycling materials or whatever you like!)
- Make a castle word search for a friend to solve.
- Bake a cake fit for a banquet. Can you follow the recipe and weigh out the ingredients you need?

ESSENTIAL

- Read each day ($\times 5$ at least per week)
- Complete the phonics homework set each week.
- Practise your handwriting by writing about something of interest to you (a story; a toy; game; something you did each week).
- Practise forming numbers correctly.

- Write down 10 facts you have learnt about castles (towards end of term)
